Diane Tedford

- Lettered in Cross Country and Track and Field at Wahconah High School; served as a Captain of Cross Country team in 1982 and 1983 and the Track and Field Team in 1984
- All Berkshire, All Western MA, and All State honors in Cross Country and Track and Field; held 12 school records in Track
- Attended Bryant College where she set records in the 800, 1500 meters, 4x800, 4x1000 and distance medley; became the first Bryant female athlete to make first team All American; selected for the National Team
- Ran on winning teams for the USA Cross Country Championships, USATF 5K Road Championships, and the 1996 Boston Marathon; Won the Buffalo Marathon in 1994
- Set 39 USA records in Track and Field Masters Division and 17 USA Track and Field records
- Inducted into the Beverly High School Athletic Hall of Fame, Bryant College Hall of Fame, and the Northeastern University Athletic Hall of Fame
