## Travel League Basketball Teams

The CRA sponsors travel basketball teams in the following age groups: Grades 3 & 4; Grades 5 & 6; and Grades 7 & 8. In order for a player to be eligible for the travel team, they must reside or go to school in the CBRSD and they must play in the CRA house league program. Teams will play in the Berkshire County Basketball League and in local tournaments. In order to be eligible for the travel team you must make one tryout. It is strongly encouraged to attend both tryouts. Fee will be due AFTER your child makes the team.
